FAMILY SERVICES PROGRAMS- Provides resources for limited income families and individuals that are facing eviction, foreclosure or other emergencies. These services include money management, budgeting, advocacy, referrals and financial assistance.

**Emergency Shelter Assistance Programs (ESGP,FPAP & FHPAP)* provides loans and financial assistance which are directed toward preventing eviction, homelessness and foreclosure.

**Rural Housing and Stability Program* assists homeless individuals and families with relocation costs, utility deposits and rent assistance to secure permanent housing.

**Family Loan Program* offers low interest loans to families with limited income for car purchase, car repairs, or the purchase of tools for work. Participants must have children and be currently working.

WEATHERIZATION - designed to help qualified households reduce their energy consumption by reducing air infiltration and insulating walls and attics. Also to reduce thermal heat loss by increasing heat system efficiency and correcting heat distribution system failures.

Head Start supports parents in their role as the primary educator of their child. Head Start works with families to identify their family strengths and to develop goals. All children must complete a physical, nutritional, dental and developmental screening. Families may be served in Home Based, Center Based, Combination or Child Care option. ADOPTION - secures permanent families for children who are legally available for adoption.

ADULT FOSTER FAMILY CARE - a living arrangement for adults who want to maintain their independence as long as possible, but need help with some daily living tasks. It is a replacement for your own home, where you move into a certified family home. There you obtain room, board and the added advantage of becoming a part of the family.

ADULT PROTECTION - provides protection to prevent and remedy situations of neglect, abuse and exploitation.

CHILD PROTECTION - works with child abuse and neglect, and child rearing problems and homeless children.

DAY CARE - provided to allow parents the opportunity to receive training or to obtain a job.

DEVELOPMENT ACHIEVEMENT CENTER - a service to enable developmentally disabled persons to receive new learning experiences to improve their personal and social functions.

FAMILY DAY CARE LICENSING - to train and license as required by law if a person is providing child care for more than one other family.

FOOD STAMPS - supplements the food buying power of low-income families or persons. Can be used for the purchase of food only. This is not to pay back grocery bills, or purchase items such as cleaning materials, tobacco, liquor, or food marked as foreign imports.

FOSTER HOME LICENSING - recruiting, training and licensing homes to provide a stable family environment for the purpose of placement when a child is not able to remain in his own home.

GENERAL ASSISTANCE - aims to meet the basic needs of families who are temporarily without support. This is not for those who are eligible for other assistance programs.

GENERAL ASSISTANCE MEDICAL CARE - assists people in meeting the costs of necessary medical care for those who are not eligible for other medical assistance.

HOMEMAKING - works with families in areas such as money management, cooking skills, better management of time, and use of available resources.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE - serves those people who are unable to pay for medical care, upon meeting certain qualifications.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE FOR PREGNANT WOMEN (MAPW) - medical assistance for pregnant women at higher income guidelines than for regular medical assets. Application form is only one page and can be picked up at your County Social Service office. Newborn infant will be covered up to age one.

MENTAL HEALTH - assists persons in resolving personal and interpersonal problems.

MINNESOTA FAMILY INVESTMENT PROGRAM (MFIP) - serves families with minor dependent children who are in financial need.

MINNESOTA SUPPLEMENTAL AID (MSA) - provides additional financial assistance to the aged, blind and disabled who do not receive adequate SSI assistance.

MONEY MANAGEMENT - designed to offer you help with financial management and planning.

RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT - provides a therapeutic experience for persons who are not capable of functioning in their own family environment.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE COUNSELING - services for families or individuals dealing with drug and alcohol problems.
